Final Judgment

THIS CAUSE having come before this Court for Final Hearing on Monday, the 18th day of July, 2022 at 8:45 a.m., upon the Petitioner/Wife's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and Other Relief and the Court, having been advised that the parties have executed a Mediated Marital Settlement Agreement, having reviewed the file and being otherwise advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. This Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this case.
2. The marriage of the Petitioner/Wife, ANA CASAS, and the Respondent/Husband, JUAN JURADO, is hereby dissolved *a vinculo matrimonii* because the marriage is irretrievably broken.
3. There are no children born of the marriage. The Wife is not pregnant and no issue is contemplated.
4. The parties entered into a Marital Settlement Agreement and Parenting Plan on June 14, 2021 (herein "Marital Settlement Agreement"), which was filed with the Court on November 4, 2021 and the First Addendum dated March 16, 2022, and Second Addendum dated June 28, 2022 (both filed on June 30, 2022). The Court finds that the Marital Settlement Agreement and Addendums were executed freely and voluntarily by the parties, that they are fair and reasonable and that it is in the best interest of the parties.

5. The parties' Marital Settlement Agreement and two (2) Addendums equitably resolves all of the issues involved in this action.

6. The parties' Marital Settlement Agreement, the First Addendum and Second Addendum are hereby ratified, approved and incorporated into this Final Judgment by reference, but it shall not merge into this Final Judgment.

7. The parties are hereby ordered to comply with the terms of their Marital Settlement Agreement, First Addendum and Second Addendum.

8. The Court retains jurisdiction over the parties and this cause to enforce the terms and conditions of their Marital Settlement Agreement, First Addendum and the Second Addendum and to enter such further orders as may be necessary.
