FINAL JUDGMENT ON SIMPLIFIED DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

This cause came before this Court on a joint Petition for Dissolution of Marriage filed on August 30, 2022. The Court, having reviewed the file, makes these findings of fact and reaches these conclusions of law:

FINDINGS:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.
2. At least one party has been a resident of the State of Florida for more than 6 months immediately before filing the Simplified Petition for Dissolution of Marriage.
3. The parties have no minor or dependent children in common and the wife is not pregnant.
4. The marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken. Therefore, the marriage between the parties is dissolved, and the parties are restored to the status of being single.
5. The parties have divided their assets and liabilities and prefer to keep their financial agreements private. Therefore, a Marital Settlement Agreement is not filed.
6. There is no marital property or marital debts to divide, as the parties previously have divided all of their personal property. Therefore, each is awarded the personal property he
