FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court on the **16th** of June 2023, and the Court having reviewed the Wife's and ~~P~~ **Other Relief and Complaint** Dissol for Equitable Lien, and the Husband's Counter Petition ~~Other~~ or Di Relief, and being thoroughly familiar with the file, and upon proper identification and proof of residency, does hereby find as follows:

A. **Jurisdiction.** The Petitioner/Wife and/or the Respondent/Husband have been domiciled and has resided in Florida for at least six (6) months prior to the filing of the Petition in this matter; therefore, the Court has jurisdiction over this cause of action and the parties hereto.

B. **Marriage.** The parties were lawfully joined in marriage on December 27, 1991, in Lake Mary, Florida.

C. **Irretrievably Broken**. The marriage is irretrievably broken.

D. **Children**: There are no minor children, and the Wife is not currently pregnant. No children are in the process of being adopted, and no children are expected.

E. **Agreement**: The parties freely and voluntarily executed a Marital Settlement Agreement on May 19, 2023, after full financial disclosure. The Marital Settlement Agreement shall not be merged into the Final Judgment but shall survive same. The parties are desirous that the Agreement be incorporated into the Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage, and the parties are being required and ordered to comply with same. All of the terms of said Agreement are incorporated herein as is same were stated verbatim. The Agreement shall not be merged in the Final Judgment but shall survive same. The Husband shall remit the alimony payments via Income Withholding Order. The Husband's Counsel shall file a Withholding Order within ten (10) days of the execution of the Marital Settlement Agreement and same is being entered concurrently with this Final Judgment. Again, until the support payments are deducted from the Husband's paycheck, the Husband shall remit the support payments directly to the Wife. The Court accepts all of the terms set forth in this Agreement, including but not limited to the durational alimony and lump sum alimony components and are enforceable as such. As such, McGladrey LLP is dropped as a party, and the Wife dismisses them with prejudice.

F. **Reservation of Jurisdiction**: This Court reserves jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter and to enforce/modify this Final Judgment and to enter any Qualified Domestic Relations Order, or other Orders necessary, to effectuate the terms of this Final Judgment and to amend the provisions in such orders as may be necessary to effectuate the terms of such orders.

It is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. That this Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this cause and the parties hereto.

2. That the marriage heretofore existing between the Petitioner, **JAMIE LISI**, and the Respondent, **JOHN LISI**, is hereby dissolved as the marriage is now irretrievably broken, and the parties are restored to the status of single.

3. **RSM US LLP (f/k/a McGladrey LLP)** is dismissed as a third party to this action with prejudice.

4. That the findings of fact above and the Marital Settlement Agreement entered into by the parties on May 19, 2023, are hereby ratified, confirmed, adopted and approved by the Court, and said Agreement, and all terms therein, is hereby accepted by this Court and incorporated into this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage as if the terms are fully set forth herein and made a part hereof. The parties are ordered to comply with all the provisions in the Agreement. The Agreement shall not merge into this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage and shall survive the entry of this Final Judgment.

5. The Husband shall be subject to immediate income deduction for the payment of all sums described above in a separate Income Withholding Order that is being entered concurrently with this Final Judgment; however, until the support payments are deducted from the Husband's paychecks, the Husband is responsible for making timely payments directly to the Wife.

6. The parties are directed to comply with all of the terms and conditions set forth in the Marital Settlement Agreement as though same were fully set forth in this Judgment verbatim.

7. The Court reserves jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter thereto and also retains jurisdiction to enforce/modify this Final Judgment.

8. The Court retains jurisdiction to enter any Qualified Domestic Relations Orders (Q D R O ' s) , C O A P s , o r o t h e r o r d e r s n e c e s s a r y t o to amend the provisions in such orders as may be necessary to effectuate the terms of such orders. The Court expressly retains jurisdiction to enter such further orders that are just, equitable and necessary to enforce or secure the benefits awarded through such orders.
