FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard upon the Petitioner's Special Interrogatories, and the Court having examined the pleadings in this action and being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

- A. That this Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties hereto.
- B. That the parties have been permanent residents of the State of Florida for more than six (6) months immediately preceding the filing of the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage.
- C. That the parties were lawfully married to each other on April 22, 2000 in Venice, Sarasota County, Florida.
- D. That there are no minor children of this marriage. The Petitioner is not pregnant, and no other children are expected.
- E. That the parties entered into a Marital Settlement Agreement on July 25, 2023, which has been duly filed with the Court.
- F. That the assets and liabilities of the parties shall be equitably distributed pursuant to the Marital Settlement Agreement.
- G. That the marriage of the parties is irretrievably broken.

It is, therefore, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

- 1. That the marriage between Susanne Gill and Robert Gill is dissolved because the marriage is irretrievably broken.
- 2. The Court finds that the parties duly executed a Marital Settlement Agreement on July 24, 2023, which has been filed with the Court; said Agreement was entered into freely and voluntarily by the parties after full disclosure by each; said Marital Settlement Agreement is adopted and ratified and incorporated by reference, but not merged into this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage and the parties are ordered to comply with its terms.

3. That the parties' assets and liabilities shall be divided as set forth in the Marital Settlement Agreement.

4. Counsel of record for the parties are discharged upon the entry of this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage.

5. That this Court retains continuing jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter herein to enter any and all orders necessary to effectuate the distribution of property and enforce the terms of this Final Judgment.
