FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE came before this court on the Parties request for entry of a Final Judgment.

On the evidence presented, this Court finds:

- A. The Court has jurisdiction of the Parties and the subject matter;
- B. The marriage of the Parties is irretrievably broken;
- C. The Parties have freely and voluntarily entered into a *Marital Settlement Agreement*, April 28, 2022, providing for the disposition of the property and debts of the Parties, and resolving all other issues relevant to this matter.

Wherefore, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The marriage of the Parties is dissolved, and each spouse is restored to the status of being single and unmarried.
2. The *Marital Settlement Agreement* dated April 28, 2022, and entered in the Court file on May 6, 2022, are hereby adopted, ratified, and incorporated into this Final Judgment and made a part hereof as though attached hereto. The parties are bound by the terms set out therein and such shall be enforceable as a part of this Final Judgment.
3. This Court retains jurisdiction of this cause to enter whatever other orders which may be required to enforce or to implement the terms of the *Marital Settlement Agreement* and this Final Judgment.

4. DISCHARGE OF ATTORNEYS. Effective thirty (30) days after the entry of Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage, John C. Stokes, Esq. and The Virga Law Firm, attorney for Petitioner, Ronald Peralta, shall be discharged as attorney of record and they shall no longer accept process of service on his behalf.
