FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon the Petitioner's *Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and Other Relief without Dependent or Minor Children*, docket item no. 7, and Respondent's, and *Counter-Petition for Dissolution of Marriage*, docket item no. 14. The Court has reviewed the file and enters the following disposition:

Findings of Fact:


1. The Court has jurisdiction over the Parties, Kemal and Shabreena Rahaman, and the subject matter of this case.
2. Both the Petitioner and the Respondent have been residents of the State of Florida for at least six months before the institution of this action.
3. The marriage is irretrievably broken and any further effort toward reconciliation would be impracticable and not in the best interests of the parties.
4. There are no minor children.
5. The Parties wish to settle their respective rights, duties, and obligations regarding their property and liabilities. To that end, the Parties have entered into a written Marital Settlement Agreement ("Agreement").
6. The executed Agreement has been filed and made part of this record.

7. Each Party entered into this Agreement voluntarily. Furthermore, before entering into the Agreement, each party had adequate time and opportunity to engage in discovery.
8. According to their Agreement, each party has waived a final hearing.

Therefore, Ordered and Adjudged:

1. The Court grants the Parties a judgment of dissolution of marriage; the bonds of matrimony existing between Kemal Rahaman and Shabreena Rahaman are hereby dissolved. Each party is restored to the status of single.
2. The Marital Settlement Agreement entered by the parties on April 19, 2023, is ratified and fully incorporated in this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage.
3. This final judgment adopts all the terms of the Agreement as if they had been fully set forth here.
4. The Parties must comply with all the terms of the Agreement.
5. This Court retains jurisdiction for the purpose of enforcing, construing, interpreting, or modifying the terms of this final judgment and the Agreement incorporated into it.
6. This Court, furthermore, retains jurisdiction to enter any ancillary orders contemplated by the Agreement, including orders to effect the division of any retirement accounts.
