SECOND AMENDED FINAL JUDGMENT AND DECREE

Upon consideration of this case, upon evidence submitted as provided by law, it is the judgment of the Court that a total divorce be granted, that is to say, a divorce vinculo matrimonii, between the parties to the above stated case, upon legal principles.

IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND DECREED by this Court that the marriage contract heretofore entered into between the parties to this case, from and after this date, be and is set aside and dissolved as fully and effectually as if no such contract had ever been made or entered into.

Petitioner and Respondent in the future shall be held and considered as separate and distinct persons altogether unconnected by any nuptial union or civil contract whatsoever, and both shall have the right to remarry.

Petitioner and Respondent hereby reaching a final resolution regarding all matters pending before this Court in the above-styled matter, this Court does hereby FIND AND ORDER the following:

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On or about May 12, 2022, Petitioner filed his Petition for Divorce in the Superior Court Fulton County. On or about May 23, 2022, the Petitioner filed Respondent's Acknowledgement of Service. The parties have since come to an Agreement regarding Custody, Visitation, Child Support regarding the minor child, Alimony, and Asset Division.

PARENTING PLAN

The parties have entered a Consent Permanent Parenting Plan ("Parenting Plan") regarding two minor children, to wit: A. Hornbaker born in 2009 and Z Hornbaker. a male child

born in 2010. The Parenting Plan is attached hereto as Exhibit A. Said Parenting Plan is incorporated herein and made a part of this Order. The Parenting Plan addresses all issues of custody, communication, and parenting time.


CHILD SUPPORT

The parties have entered a comprehensive Child Support Addendum and a corresponding Child Support Worksheet attached as Exhibit B, resolving all issues related to the support and maintenance of the Children. The Child Support Addendum has been executed and is being submitted to the Court contemporaneously herewith and is incorporated herein by reference. In the event of any conflict, the terms of the Child Support Addendum shall control.

EQUITABLE DIVISION

The parties have entered into a comprehensive Settlement Agreement which divides all the marital assets. Said Settlement Agreement is incorporated herein and made part of this Order. The Settlement Agreement incorporates all issues of distribution and division of marital assets.
