FINAL JUDGMENT AND DECREE OF DIVORCE

Upon consideration of this case and upon the evidence submitted as provided by law, it is the judgment of the Court that a total divorce be granted, that is to say, a divorce, *a vinculo matrimonii*, between the parties to the above-stated case upon legal principals.

It is considered, ordered, and decreed by the Court that the marriage contract heretofore entered into between the parties to this case, from and after this date, be and is set aside and dissolved as fully and effectually as if no such contract had ever been made or entered into.

Plaintiff and Defendant in the future shall be held and considered as separate and distinct persons altogether unconnected by any nuptial union or civil contract whatsoever and both shall have the right to remarry.

IT IS HEREBY THE ORDER OF THIS COURT AS FOLLOWS:

1.

The parties have entered into a written agreement signed by the Plaintiff and Defendant on November 16, 2023 settling between themselves all issues arising from this action in reference to alimony, custody, child support, and division of the property of the parties, as well as, all other matters relating to the marital relationship. Said written agreement is hereby approved by the Court and is made a part of this Final Judgment and Decree of Divorce.

2.

The parties have one minor child, to wit: P. Miller born 2014. The parties have fully agreed to terms of custody and visitation as set forth on the parties Consent Parenting Plan entered into between the parties. Said Consent Parenting Plan is approved by separate order of the court. The parties have agree to terms of child support as set forth on the Child Support Addendum which is approved by separate order of the Court.

3.

THEREFORE, each party of the above-stated case is hereby commanded to abide by all of the terms and provisions of the Settlement Agreement made between the parties is incorporated herein and made part of the Final Judgment as if fully set forth herein. Each party is hereby enjoined and restrained from violating any of the terms of the said Settlement Agreement and this Order as any such violation of said terms by either party will be considered and treated as contempt of this Court.
