FINAL JUDGMENT AND DECREE OF DIVORCE

Upon consideration of evidence submitted and upon legal principles, the Court grants a total divorce, a divorce *a vinculo matrimonii*, to Plaintiff and Defendant. The Court orders and decrees that the marriage contract heretofore entered into between Plaintiff and Defendant, from and after this date, be set aside and dissolved as if no such contract had ever been made or entered into, and Plaintiff and Defendant, formerly husband and wife, in the future shall be held and considered as separate and distinct persons, altogether unconnected by any nuptial union or civil contract whatsoever.

The maiden/former name of the wife, REGINA ALLISON BIGGS, is restored to her.

The *Settlement Agreement* between the parties filed August 23, 2023 is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Final Judgment and Decree. Each party is ORDERED to comply with the terms and provisions therein.

As required by O.C.G.A. § 19-6-15(m)(1), the CHILD SUPPORT WORKSHEETS filed September 18, 2023 are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Final Judgment & Decree.

The CHILD SUPPORT ADDENDUM filed herewith is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Final Judgment and Decree. Each party is ORDERED to comply with the terms and provisions therein. In case of any conflict between the *Settlement Agreement*, if any, and the *Child Support Addendum*, then the *Child Support Addendum* shall govern.

The drafting mandates of O.C.G.A. § 19-9-1, regarding a Permanent Parenting Plan have been satisfied by the PARENTING PLAN filed herewith which is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Final Judgment & Decree. Each party is ORDERED to comply with the terms and provisions therein. In case of any conflict between the *Settlement Agreement*, if any, and the *Parenting Plan*, then the *Parenting Plan* shall govern.

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §§ 19-6-30, 32 & 33, whenever in violation of the terms of this Final Judgment and Decree, there shall have been a failure to make the support payments due hereunder so that the amount unpaid is equal to or greater than the amount payable for one month, the payments required to be made may be collected by the process of continuing garnishment for support and/or by Income Deduction Order for Award of Child Support.


