FINAL JUDGMENT AND DECREE OF DIVORCE

Upon consideration of this case, upon evidence submitted as provided by law, it is the judgment of the Court that a total divorce be and hereby is granted, that is to say a divorce *a vinculo matrimonii*, between the parties to the above-captioned case upon legal principles.

It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** that:

1. The marriage contract heretofore entered into between Sandra Bevins and Marc Bevins, from and after this date, shall be and hereby is set aside and dissolved as fully and effectually as if no such contract had ever been made or entered into; and

2. Sandra Bevins and Marc Bevins, formerly Wife and Husband, in the future shall be held and considered as separate and distinct persons altogether, unconnected by any nuptial union or civil contract whatsoever.

3. Plaintiff herein, Sandra Bevins, shall have the right to remarry, and Defendant herein, Marc Bevins, shall also have the right to remarry.


