FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE came before this Court for a hearing on the parties' Petition for Simplified Dissolution of Marriage. The Court, having reviewed the file and heard the testimony, makes these findings of fact and reaches these conclusions of law:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.
2. At least one party has been a resident of the State of Florida for more than 6 months immediately before filing the Petition for Simplified Dissolution of Marriage.
3. The parties have no minor or dependent children in common, and the Wife is not pregnant.
4. The marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken. Therefore, the marriage between the parties is dissolved, and the parties are restored to the status of being single.
5. The parties voluntarily entered into a Marital Settlement Agreement dated July 11, 2023, and filed with this Court on July 18, 2023. Therefore, the Marital Settlement Agreement is ratified and made a part of this Final Judgment. The parties are ordered to obey all of its provisions.

6. **Award of Assets to Wife.** By operation of this Judgment, pursuant to Section 61.075(4) FLA. STAT., and Rule 12.570(e), FLA.FAM.L.R.P., the Wife, ELIZABETH FOSTER, is awarded and distributed all of the parties' interest in and to the real property described as:

LOT 1, ADDITION NO. 2 TO CHEROKEE HILLS, AS PER MAP OR PLAT THEREOF, RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 2, PAGE 73, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF LEON COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Title to the assets shall vest in Wife.

7. The Court reserves jurisdiction to enforce the Marital Settlement Agreement.

8. Effective thirty-one (31) days after the entry of the Final Judgment each party's attorney shall automatically be discharged as attorney of record and shall no longer be authorized to accept service of process on behalf of the client.
