FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon Petitioner's Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and the Marital Settlement Agreement and the Addendum to Marital Settlement Agreement of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

1. **JURISDICTION**: The Court has jurisdiction over the parties, RYAN CHRISTOPHER RODEMS, and TAMI A. RODEMS, and subject matter.
2. **RESIDENCY**: Petitioner has been a resident of the State of Florida for more than six months preceding the filing of the Petition.
3. **AFFIDAVIT OF NON-MILITARY SERVICE**: Neither Petitioner nor Respondent are persons in the military services of the United States as defined by the Amended Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1976.
4. **DATE AND PLACE OF MARRIAGE**: The parties were married to each other on May 11, 1996 in Tampa, Florida.
5. **GROUND - IRRETRIEVABLY BROKEN**: The marriage between the Petitioner, RYAN CHRISTOPHER RODEMS, and the Respondent, TAMI A. RODEMS, is irretrievably broken.
6. **SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**: The parties have made provisions for the division of their real and personal property and the payment of their marital debts, through the Marital Settlement Agreement dated December 26, 2022 and the Addendum to Marital Settlement Agreement dated October 5, 2023 which are fair, equitable and is in the best interests

of the parties.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

A. **JURISDICTION**: This Court has absolute jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action.


B. **DISSOLUTION**: The bonds of marriage heretofore existing between Petitioner, RYAN CHRISTOPHER RODEMS, and the Respondent, TAMI A. RODEMS, are dissolved.

C. **SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**: The Marital Settlement Agreement dated December 26, 2022 and the Addendum to Marital Settlement Agreement dated October 5, 2023 are hereby approved and incorporated into this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage by reference, and the parties are ordered to comply with said agreements.

D. **RESERVATION OF JURISDICTION**: The Court reserves jurisdiction for a Qualified Domestic Relations Order to effectuate the equitable distribution. This Court retains jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter for the enforcement or modification of this judgment.
