**FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE**

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard on the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage filed by Wife, KASSANDRA QUICK, and the Acceptance of Service, Answer, and Waiver filed by the Husband, PATRICK QUICK, and the Court, after reviewing the pleadings filed in this cause and otherwise being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

1. That this Honorable Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this action and the parties hereto.
2. That the parties were married to one another on January 9, 2011, in Punta Gorda, Florida.
3. That there was one (1) minor child born during the parties' marriage, L.H.Q., whose date of birth is January 13, 2013. No more children are expected, and the Wife is not pregnant.
4. That the Wife has been a resident of the State of Florida for at least six (6) months before the filing of the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage.
5. That the marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken.

6. That the parties entered into a Marital Settlement Agreement, which resolves all outstanding issues between the parties.
7. That the parties entered into a Parenting Plan which is in the child's best interest.

It is therefore, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. That the bonds of marriage between the Wife, KASSANDRA QUICK, and the Husband, PATRICK QUICK, are hereby dissolved because the marriage is irretrievably broken.
2. That the Marital Settlement Agreement and Parenting Plan, which were entered into by and between the parties, are hereby approved, ratified and incorporated into this Final Judgment by reference, and the Husband and Wife are ordered to comply with same.
3. That the Court retains jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this action for the purpose of enforcement of this decree and to adjudicate any reserved upon issues and for all other purposes legally allowed.
